Synopsis

“El Final del Estilo Romantico” is a modern crime drama about a love triangle that culminates in an intense and deadly bank robbery. The film will be almost entirely spoken in Spanish.

Casting

OPEN CASTING until February 28.

There are three PRINCIPAL characters:

Diego – Hispanic, mid/late 20s – a likeable, good looking, romantic but violent criminal who never seems to make the right decision. He resents Julian and his relationship with Lucero, his former girlfriend before being arrested. Diego desires goodness, but for selfish reasons.

Julian – Hispanic, mid/late 20s – childhood friend of Diego and Lucero, his levelheadedness, consistency and persistence won him Lucero's affection shortly after Diego was incarcerated. He always tries to do the right thing.

Lucero – Hispanic, mid/late 20s – fed up with Diego after his incarceration, Lucero soon found comfort in Julian's arms, though her feelings for Diego have resurfaced since his release. Quiet and good natured, Lucero believes a smile can change the world.

SECONDARY characters:

Hooker, Bank Manager, Bank Teller, Corrections Officer

EXTRAS especially needed on March 13 and 14 for shooting of bank heist sequence.

Scheduled for production March 6-7, 13-14 and 21, with pickups on March 28, “Estilo” is written and directed by award-winning independent filmmaker Jason R. Johnston (WILD's Film Festival 2008: Best Director, “Files”) and produced by Edward Cordero (Cinesol Film Festival 36 Hour Film Race 2009: First Place, “Sex, Trafficking and Luchadores”).
